#### PRIORITY ENROLLMENT FOR 2021-2022

March 1st - 19th, 2021, has been designated as the New Student/Preschool/Transitional Kindergarten/Kindergarten Registration period for students in grades Preschool – 8th grade. Although we will continue to take registrations after this period, students registered during this time will receive priority in placement.

To enroll in preschool for the 2021-22 school year, your child must be 3 or 4 years old (priority goes to children who are 4 years old or will turn 4 by Sept 1st.

To enroll in Transitional Kindergarten, your child must turn 5 between Sept 2nd – Dec 2nd.

To enroll in Kindergarten, your child must be 5 year old by Sept 1st.

Enrollment packets for Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten can be picked up from any school front office, the ECE Office (2016 Paloma Ave) or the District Office (2010 W Swain Rd) beginning March 1st.

Your 6<sup>th</sup> grade student will need to either:

- Get a Tdap booster shot
  or
- Provide documentation that they already received the booster

Documentation needed by the school is the yellow shot record showing the date, type of vaccine given and doctor's name/name of clinic.

Proof of the Tdap booster must be submitted to the school office <u>NO LATER THAN</u> <u>MARCH 5, 2021</u> for priority 7<sup>th</sup> grade placement.
