Last week the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) updated their guidance for K-12 schools. Included in this guidance are new recommendations for quarantine when a student is exposed to a positive case in a school environment. Schools may now take one of two approaches when identifying potentially exposed students. You may be receiving notifications that you have not seen before, related to either of these approaches, as we respond to a rising number of cases in our schools. Please be sure to read notifications sent to you and reach out to your child's school site if you have questions.

We recognize that the changing guidance and recommendations can be confusing and difficult to understand. Each of our school sites has a nurse on staff to answer questions, give guidance and provide follow up as needed. We have also updated the School Safety Plan on the district's web page.

We would like to remind all families to continue to have students check daily for symptoms of COVID before coming to school or participating in extracurricular activities. If they experience symptoms, they should stay home. We also want to remind all members of our community that masks are required indoors for all persons over the age of two, on all of our school campuses and at all school events. Thank you in advance for your ongoing cooperation in the implementation of these mitigation measures, designed to keep our students, staff and families safe and healthy.
